- Dr. Lamonte responded that she felt the board members should not be on the committee, as the committee should make the recommendation to the board.
- Mrs. Johnson-Demeter asked who wrote the letter to the parents; Mrs. Vogel stated that Mr. Glowacky and she collaborated on the letter.
- Dr. Lamonte stated that no Warren or Sussex school districts have uniforms as their dress policy. The Board has a dress policy and if it was followed there should not be an issue. A teacher is worried about teaching a lesson, not the dress code.
- Mr. Roschewsk asked if it would be easier to list what could be worn instead of what cannot be worn.
- Administration will need to enforce the dress code policy.
- Mr. Shotwell prefers to see a modified dress code over a uniform.
- Mr. Colucci suggested that the dress code be broadcast over the video announcements regularly.
- The Board then questioned the number of students in each program. There was a discussion about several programs with low enrollment. The new AP History class was withdrawn due to the lack of students. The Board requested that the schedule be reviewed to consolidate classes if possible.
- Mr. Roschewsk requested that the administration look at adding a computer science program, he feels that there will be a great interest in the program.
