Policy #0167- PUBLIC PARTICIPATION IN BOARD MEETINGS

Section: Bylaws

Date Created: March, 2000

Date Edited: September, 2012

The Board of Education recognizes the value of public comment on educational issues and the importance of allowing members of the public to express themselves on school matters of community interest.

In order to permit the fair and orderly expression of such comment, the Board shall set aside a portion of every Board meeting, the length of the portion to be determined by the Board, for public comment on any school or school district issue that a member of the public feels may be of concern to the residents of the school district.

Public participation shall be governed by the following rules:

1. A participant must be recognized by the presiding officer and must preface comments by an announcement of his/her name, place of residence, and group affiliation, if appropriate;
2. Each statement made by a participant shall be limited to three (3) minutes' duration;
3. No participant may speak more than once on the same topic until all others who wish to speak on that topic have been heard;
4. All statements shall be directed to the presiding officer; no participant may address or question Board members individually;
5. The presiding officer may:
 - a. Interrupt, warn, or terminate a participant's statement when the statement is too lengthy, abusive, obscene, or irrelevant;
 - b. Request any individual to leave the meeting when that person does not observe reasonable decorum;
 - c. Request the assistance of law enforcement officers in the removal of a disorderly person when that person's conduct interferes with the orderly progress of the meeting;
 - d. Call for a recess or an adjournment to another time when the lack of public decorum so interferes with the orderly conduct of the meeting as to warrant such action; and
 - e. Waive these rules when necessary for the protection of privacy or the efficient administration of the Board's business.

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- A parent stated that she received a letter from WCSSSD stating that her child would need to go to another school because the program was no longer available. She is very happy that her child will be able to continue at Warren Tech and is sure they will receive everything they need.
- A student expressed her interest in starting a journalism club and a school newspaper.
- Mr. Bossard supports the club and is interested in being the advisor.
- Ms. LePera asked the Board to add a book to the approved book list.
- Ms. Clark stated that she is excited to be working directly for Warren County Technical School.
- The president of the PTA encouraged everyone to join and attend the meetings on the first Tuesday of each month.
- Freeholder Director Smith stated that he feels the new programs will succeed.
- Ms. Schubert thanked the Board for approving her as a co-advisor for the Freshman Class.
